About the Partnership

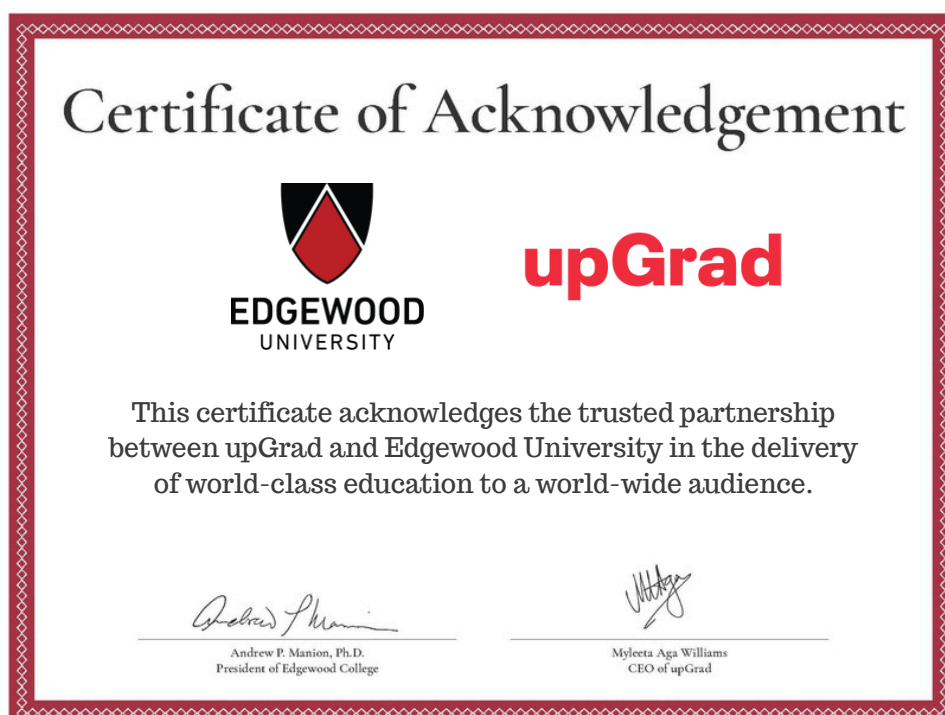

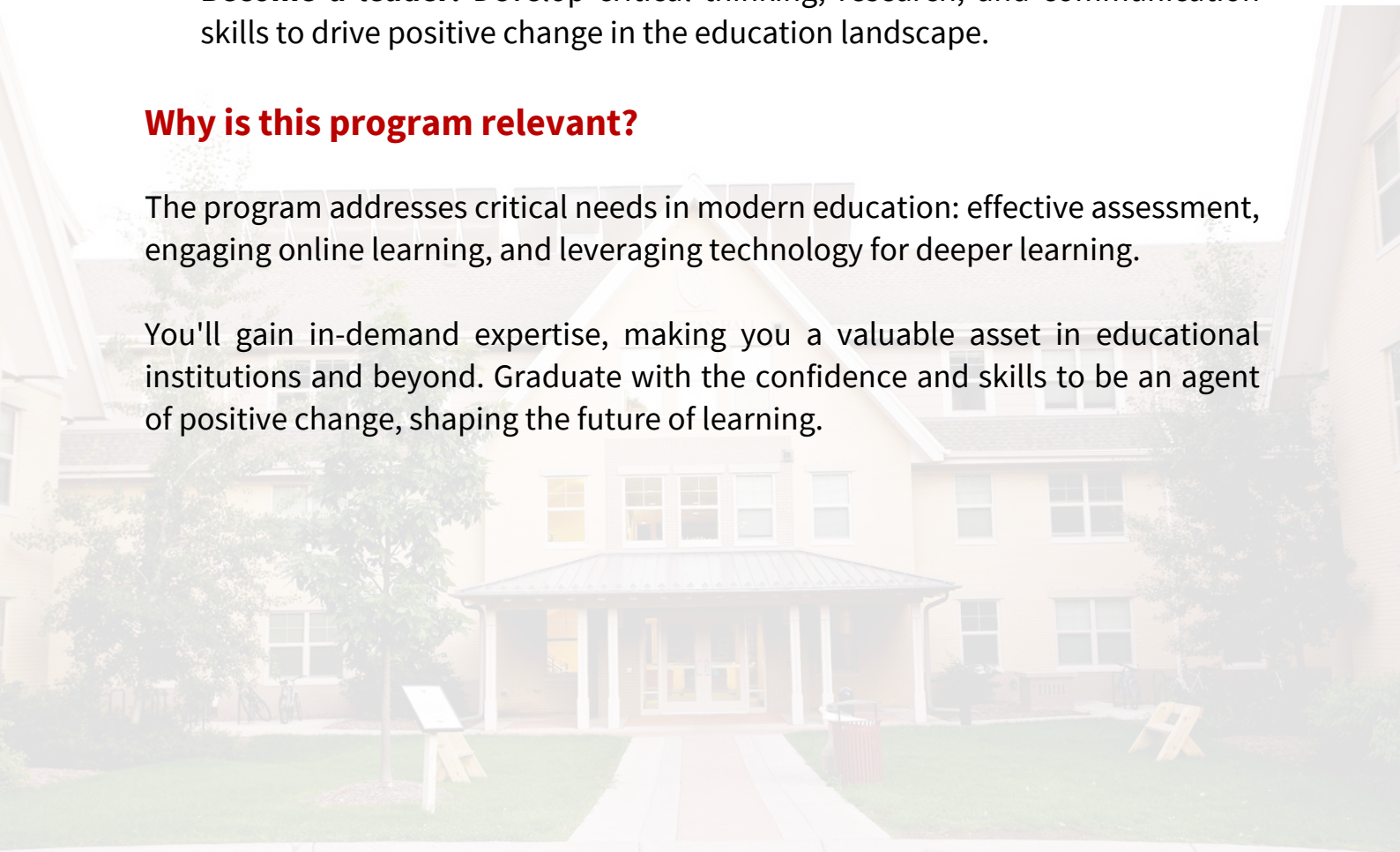
